

Miss Pekin Riding Club- 2010 Guidelines and Procedures

Congratulations! You have been chosen as the Miss Pekin Riding Club 2010. The pride and honor of wearing this crown brings with it a tremendous amount of responsibility. Be sure and read the contract carefully; when you sign your contract you will be accepting the challenge of representing The Pekin Riding Club.

Conduct:

From the time you win the title of Miss Pekin Riding Club 2010 until you relinquish the crown at the end of your reign, you will be in the spotlight. It is imperative that you conduct yourself accordingly, whether it is on a personal level or as Miss Pekin Riding Club.

Throughout your reign you will be expected to portray the highest moral standards, show the true ideals of young womanhood.

You will be expected to conduct yourself as an example to the public which includes no smoking, drinking, chewing, foul language or inappropriate social behavior.

You must not have been pregnant, nor shall you during the year of your reign.

Miss Pekin Riding Club works to promote a positive image of the Pekin Riding Club and the equestrian way of life.

Miss Pekin Riding Club will be required to carry the flag at all the shows she attends, will help carry the 50/50 bucket, will work one show and will attend the annual awards banquet to help hand out awards. Miss PRC may also be asked to participate in parades.

The PRC Queen will be asked to provide photos or interviews for local media and will be required to dress in clean, nice jeans with a collared shirt and boots at all PRC shows.

*Failure to fulfill the duties as described here will be grounds for Miss PRC to forfeit her title and the First Runner up will take her place as Miss Pekin Riding Club.
